Features of Implementation of the Degree Program for Disabled Persons and Persons with Special Needs

The training of persons with special needs is conducted depending on their individual needs, including by the individual curriculum and with the use of adapted programs of disciplines (modules) and practices. If necessary, the students with special needs may be provided for with social psychosocial help and support.

In case of training of persons with special needs by the individual curriculum, the university may prolong the period for degree program completion by not more than one year in comparison with the period established for the internal study mode.

Persons with special needs are provided for with the selection of the practice location taking into account their health status and accessibility requirements.

Students from among persons with special needs are provided for with printed and electronic learning resources in forms adaptive for their disabilities.

The university establishes the requirements to the procedure of state final certification tests, including those for disabled persons and persons with special needs considering their health status in accordance with the applicable regulatory legal acts.

SPCPU has the necessary equipment providing adaptation of electronic and printed learning resources for students from among persons with special needs, as well as equipment proving their mobility:

- information terminal "TS-Tiflo" for persons with vision and hearing impairment, as well as persons in wheelchairs (intended to exchange, obtain and transfer information for persons with hearing and vision impairment, as well as persons with musculoskeletal disorders, including reference information on training agenda),

- magnifying portable device DIONOPTICVISION (for students with vision impairment in order to enlarge the text and select contrasting image schemes),

- electronic manual video magnifier BiggerD2.5-43 TV (for students with vision impairment in order to enlarge the text and make the flat-printed text readable),

- radio class (radio microphone) "Sonet-RSM" RM 6-1 (behind-the-ear inductor) (portable FM sound system for students with hearing impairment, which improves the perception of voice information),

- track-type mobile stair lift BARS-UGP-130 for persons with special needs (for persons with musculoskeletal disorders, for climbing stairs by a person in a wheelchair and in case the lift is operated by a person accompanying the user).

SPCPU has dedicated software for persons with special needs (screen reader Nvda for system and office applications, including web-browsers, email clients, web messengers and office software suites).
